9	FRANCE RHONE	Crozes Hermitage, "Les Pierrelles", Albert Belle A rich, savoury example from one of the leading lights of the region. Well balanced with dark fruits and subtle spice combined with well integrated wood.	£18.50
10	FRANCE BORDEAUX	St Emilion, Chateau Rochers Mirande A St Emilion with a growing reputation. Good Merlot fruit on the palate balanced with some tannins & oak.	£17.95
11	SPAIN	Rioja, "Crianza", Luis Canas Twelve months oak ageing give a little complexity and softens the wine - yielding a well balanced ripe fruited wine with a soft, sweetish oak finish.	£17.50
12	ITALY	Chianti Classico DOCG, Castello di Meleto A superbly balanced medium bodied red with juicy red fruit character and hints of dried cherries and chocolate. The palate is structured but never heavy, supremely savoury and very moreish.	£17.95
13	S.AFRICA	Original Cabernet, Raats Family Bruwer Raats makes some of the best Cabernet in South Africa but it's usually significantly pricier than this. Using some of the barrels that didn't quite make the cut for his top wine, he has produced a stunning, juicy, succulent red crammed full of redcurrants, brambles and cassis.	£18.95
14	ARGENTINA	Malbec, Santa Rosa Quickly becoming the most important red for Argentina, this Bordeaux export produces full, robust wines with deep plummy fruit, structured tannins and good length.	£15.95
15	CHILE	Carmenere, Armador, Odfjell Stunning value Carmenere that really shows the potential of this variety when fully ripe. Savoury, creamy and lush with spicy olive laced flavour.	£14.95
16	AUSTRALIA	Shiraz, Terra Barossa, Thorn Clarke, Eden Valley Thorn-Clarke's family history of grape growing date back to the 1850's and as such they have some of the oldest Shiraz vines in the country. This wine is deep crimson red with bright, juicy black fruits and hints of spice. Soft, creamy fruit and touches of coffee on the palate make for a superb value example of	£18.95
