1	FRANCE LOIRE	<b>Muscadet De Sevres Et Maine Sur Lie, "Les Vignes Blanches", Domaine Menard Gaborit</b> From one of the top estates in Muscadet. The wine is left on its lees to give it more fruit flavour and character. Dry and crisp but with good depth of flavour and fruit. Excellent with all shell fish.	£15.50
2	FRANCE LOIRE	<b>Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Crochet</b> Classic Sancerre - dry with leaf blackcurrant and gooseberry fruit and a cool, lingering finish.	£20.90
3	FRANCE BURGUNDY	<b>Chablis, Jean Claude Martin</b> Crisp and dry with racy acidity and taught apple and citrus fruit flavours. Well balanced, showing some complexity and a clean refreshing finish.	£20.90
4	ITALY	<b>Pinot Grigio IGT Venezia Giulia 'L'Elfo', Sacchetto</b> A well rounded, more serious example of Pinot Grigio that displays tangy green apple and melon fruit coupled with a long, minerally finish.	£16.50
5	S.AFRICA	<b>Chenin Blanc, McGregor</b> A deliciously crisp and lively example of Chenin with bags of crunchy apple like fruit, slight grassiness and a good clean finish.	£14.95
6	ARGENTINA	<b>Viognier, Santa Rosa</b> Santa Rosa were one of the first wineries in Argentina to produce Viognier and it has been a massive hit. Well balanced, with crisp acidity and measured alcohol. Apricot fruit dominates with just a touch of spice.	£14.95
7	CHILE	<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Armador, Odfjell</b> Produced from fruit grown in the cool Casablanca Valley, this is crisp, well defined and full of juicy grapefruit and gooseberry character.	£15.95
8	AUSTRALIA	<b>Chardonnay, Stella Bella</b> A spectacularly fine, tight knit Chardonnay showing great elegance and style. Crisp lemony character overlaid with nutty, well integrated oak flavours. More Burgundian than Australian but with underlying new world panache!	£19.95
